## General Tournament information's

### Tournamentdesk:

The tournament desk is located on the ground floor directly next to the stairs. Responsible crew for the planning and execution of the tournament: Michael Gäde, Natalia Kotkolik und Biggi Leuschner

The Tournament Referee is Nilo Vidal.

All rules as stated in the official entry form and ESF regulations apply. All results will be displayed in the center and online (Tournament Software).

### Practice Courts

On Thursday during the day, courts will be available to all players for free. Of course, if you want to be sure to have a court, you can book one and pay for it.

On earlier days and Wednesday evening, courts need to be reserved and paid for.

On Thursday before the event starts, everyone is free to use the courts. Courts CANNOT be reserved, so everyone has a fair chance to have a hit.

### Games & Starting times

Be aware that the matches will not be announced when they start. This means that each player is personally responsible to be in time at the designated court for his game. This also implies that if previous matches cause a delay or finish early the player has to be present as soon as the preceding match is finished.

After the match, BOTH players have to ref the next match. After finishing refereeing, the refs are asked to bring to score sheet AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to the tournament desk. In this way, delays can be prevented.

### WIFI

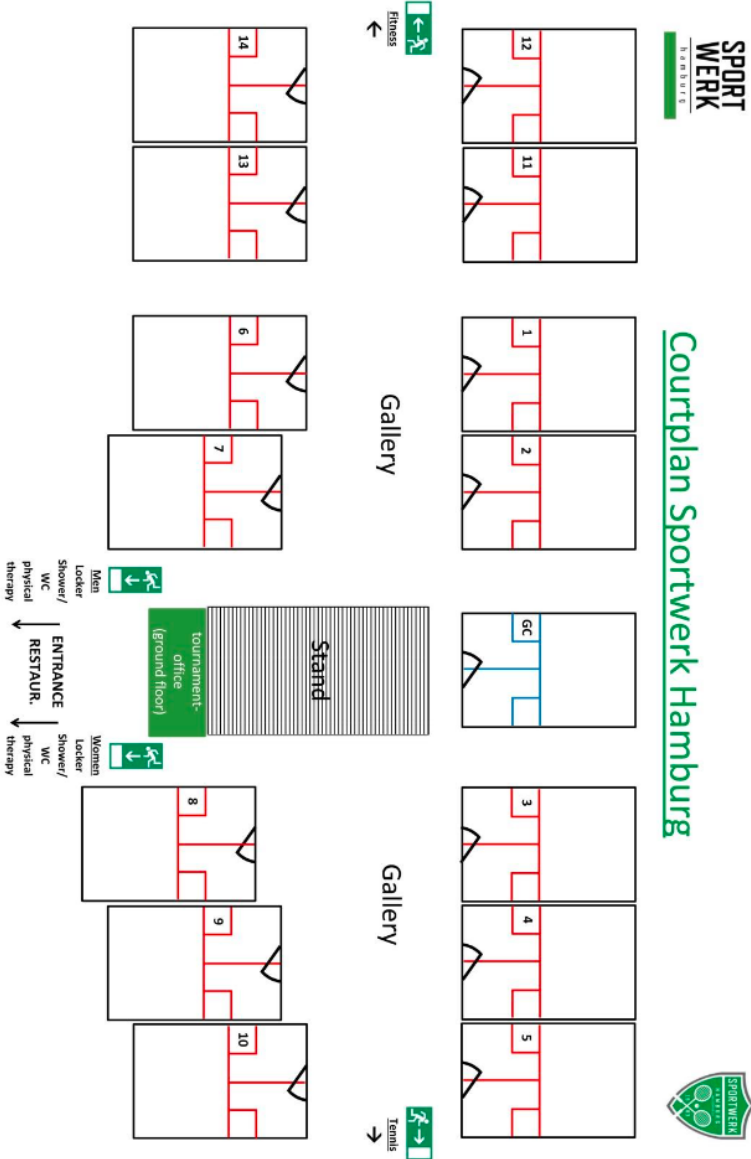
There is no WIFI available during the tournament.

## Menu Innerluck Restaurant

Please be aware, the tournament buffet does NOT take place in the squashcenter. But zoom away by foot in Restaurant Innerluck. (See map below)
