The German Junior Open is open to all players under the age of 13, 15, 17, 19 on the 25th of February 2024, as appropriate. Players may only enter one category.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION FOR INDIVIDUAL NEUTRAL ATHLETES OF RUSSIAN AND BELARUSIAN SPORTING NATIONALITY. PLAYERS MUST SIGN THE DOCUMENT AND NEED TO BE APPROVED BY THE WSF AND ESF OFFICE.

MATCHES & SCORING

All matches will be played as best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. PAR scoring to 11 will be used at all tournaments on the ESF Junior Circuit (to 2 clear points).

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

PRIZES

There will be prize money in the U19 categories and trophies in all other categories. Prize money will only be given AFTER the prizegiving ceremony!

Group entries must be sent by the group entry form

All entries must be made through / endorsed by the relevant national federation. Any entry not endorsed by a player's national federation will not be accepted. All entries will be acknowledged and published on the tournament website.

DRAWS/SEEDINGS

The seeding and timings for the first match will be circulated to all players or their national/regional associations by e-mail, at least 5 days before the start of the event. Times of first matches will be indicated for their players. The seeding will be carried out using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the closing date and in accordance with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines.

EYE GUARDS

All competitors at ESF approved Junior tournaments must wear approved protective eye guards, manufactured to an appropriate national safety standard, properly over the eyes at all times during competition play. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product is satisfactory for the purpose. Players will not be allowed to compete without this protection. Only eye wear approved by the WSF are allowed. See www.worldsquash.org.

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance. All players have to wear approved protective eye guards on court.

The German Junior Open will be publishing draws, results, photos of players as well as live footage from matches, players and the venue. The German Junior Open 2024 is registered with PSA as a Closed Satellite. The best 32 players (girls and boys) in the u17 and u19 categories can claim points with the PSA.
